



Manly Council's Hall and Reserve hire FAQs



Frequently asked Questions and Answers.

Q. What is the fee for a wedding ceremony in the Manly Council area?

A. The fee for a wedding ceremony is \$351.20 There is a refundable fee of \$100.00 for a wedding sign which is to be placed at the designated site on the reserve by the hirer.

Q. Do I need to make a booking for my picnic or function?

A. You need to make a booking only if there are more than 30 people expected / invited to attend or if it is a Corporate Function.

Q. What are the hours I can hold my picnics/function in parks and reserves?

A. Picnics/Functions can be held between 8.00am and 10.00pm.



Q. Can I reserve a gazebo / table / barbeque?

A. Reservations cannot be accepted, as Gazebos, tables and barbeques are on a first come / share basis.

Q. Can I consume alcohol in parks and reserves?

A. The consumption of alcohol is prohibited on all Manly Council parks and reserves that display the relevant signage (as per Section 632 the Local Government Act 1993).

Q, Can I erect a jumping castle?

A. You will need to apply for a permit and pay the fees for the reserve space. Jumping castles are permitted at Queenscliff Lagoon Reserve, Clontarf and Little Manly Point (pending approval).

Q. Do you take bookings for Manly Dam?

A. Manly Dam bookings are through Warringah Council (phone 9942 2545) or via the website www.warringah.nsw.gov.au

Q. Can I hold a party in Manly Council venues or halls?

A. Parties are not permitted in the Manly Council's venues.

Q. Do you hire venues for 18th birthdays or 21st birthdays?

A. Manly Council does not permit any parties in its venues.

Q. Do you take bookings for Manly Surf Club?

Q. Do you take bookings for Manly Community Centre?

A. Manly Community Centre takes its own bookings: phone 99771066.

Q. Do you permit marquees on Clontarf Reserve or Shelly Beach?

A. Marquees are not permitted on Shelly Beach. Marquees may be approved for Clontarf Reserve, following assessment of an application.

Q. Can I gain access to a reserve/area through a boom gate?

A. You must complete an application form to request access. The Fee and bonds are applicable through Manly Council Customer Service 9976 1500 or email your request to records@manly.nsw.gov.au

Q. Are corporate functions permitted on Shelly Beach?

A. Corporate functions are not permitted on Shelly Beach
